

EXPOSE THE HARM

Expose the Harm Confidentiality and Moderation Statement

We do not ask for details that identify you (for example, your name or address). Our policy is one of confidentiality. We will only break confidentiality if you share details from which you can be identified as well as information that leaves us concerned that a child or adult is currently at risk of harm by another person. In that situation, we would pass your submission onto social services or the police.

All submissions are moderated to ensure that those that are published:

- Are about the harms of child and adolescent exposure to pornography
- Do not identify you or someone else.

We publish here as many submissions as we can and our hope is that they will all contribute to the public conversation about the harms of pornography on children and young people, and to effective and speedy action to protect and support them.

We take your privacy seriously and operate high standards of data protection within our team. However please bear in mind that we cannot guarantee that once published your story will not be copied, re-published and commented on by others online, including by media outlets.
